

Assistance for Individuals and Families

Let's recap what we've covered so far. Access Health CT offers individuals and families a way to find out if they are eligible for:

- Public Health Programs such as Medicaid (HUSKY A and D) and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP or HUSKY B Band 1 and Band 2).
- Qualified Health Plans with possible federal affordability subsidies or assistance that reduces the cost of health insurance coverage and comes in two forms: Advance Premium Tax Credits (APTCs) which lowers premium costs and Cost Sharing Reductions (CSRs) which lowers out-ofpocket costs. There will be more detail on these 2 terms later in this module.



- Covered Connecticut Connecticut residents that meet specific eligibility requirements will pay \$0 for
 their health insurance coverage through Access Health CT, thanks to the Covered Connecticut Program
 created by the State of Connecticut. The Covered Connecticut Program provides no-cost Qualified Health
 Plan insurance coverage, plus no-cost Dental Coverage and Non-Emergency Medical Transportation
 (NEMT) administered by the Connecticut Department of Social Services.
- Standalone Dental Plan will be reviewed in a separate module.
